Part I Why God Saved Us

Lesson 1 – Why Do We Need to Study the Doctrine of Salvation If We Are Already a

Christian? Paul's admonition about other gospels. How our efforts to truncate the Gospel distorts how we understand the Christian faith and how we live. The worldview assumed by the Gospel. A snapshot overview of the full scope of salvation (ordo salutis and historia salutis). Use of the Westminster standards in exploring salvation.

Lesson 2—**What is the Goal of our Salvation?** *The Covenant of Works as intrinsic to salvation. Man as bearing the image of God and man as in communion with God. The chief end of man.*

Part II How God Saved Us

Lesson 4—**What is the Saving Work of God?** The Apostle Paul and the trifecta of salvation: atonement, resurrection, and Pentecost. What we lose if we lose sight of the unity of the atonement, resurrection, and Pentecost in the work of God.

Lesson 5—**How Is Christ's Work Able to Apply to Us?** Salvation as undergirded by the pactum salutis. Foreknowledge, Predestination, Election, and Union with Christ. Recognizing how union with Christ is of central importance to the Christian life.
